The Atlanta Marriott Century Center Hotel is located in Northeast Atlanta at 2000 Century Boulevard NE, right off I-85. Make yourself at home in stylish renovated rooms featuring sleek décor, platform beds, flat-screen TV's and spa-like bathrooms.
