Tour 2 – THE ATLANTA HISTORY CENTER

The Atlanta History Center consists of 33 acres of four historic houses, nine distinct gardens and nine permanent exhibits. The Atlanta History Center is also home to the Cyclorama, one of only two in the United States. The other one is in Gettysburg, PA, making Atlanta home to one of America's national treasures. The Cyclorama is a 132 year old hand painted work of art that stand 49 feet tall, is longer than a football field, weighs 10,000 pounds and was at one time the largest painting in the world. The painting depicts the Battle of Atlanta and was created as a traveling attraction after the Civil War. It was donated to Atlanta in 1898 and was housed in Grant Park, until it found a new home at the Atlanta History Center in 2019. Lunch is Dutch treat at a local fast food restaurant.

Mary Mac’s has been in business since 1945 when a restaurant owned by a woman was called a Tea Room.
