The Renaissance Tulsa Hotel & Convention Center, located at 6808 South 107th East Avenue, Tulsa, Oklahoma. Located in Tulsa (South Tulsa), Renaissance Tulsa Hotel & Convention Center is within a 15-minute drive of Tulsa Expo Center and Oral Roberts University. This hotel is 9 mi (14.5 km) from University of Tulsa and 9.4 mi (15.2 km) from Oklahoma Aquarium.

The Tentative Schedule of Events is included with this packet.

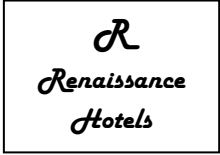

Tulsa International Airport is a civil-military airport five miles (8 km) northeast of Downtown Tulsa, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, United States. It was named **Tulsa Municipal Airport** when the city acquired it in 1929; it received its present name in 1963. While Tulsa International Airport only serves domestic destinations, it is still an international airport since it has customs and border patrol facilities.

Distance from the Renaissance Tulsa Hotel – 10.0 miles.

Driving Directions

From Tulsa International Airport – get on OK-11 E from E Virgin Street. Take US-169 S to E 71st St South. Take the 71st St. south exit from US-169 South. Continue on E 71st St. South. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto E 71st Street south. Turn left onto South 109th E. Avenue. Turn left onto East 69th Street. East 68th Street turns slightly right and becomes South 107th east Avenue. Turn left and hotel on the right.

From Oklahoma City via I-44 East. Take I-44 East and OK-364 to East 71st street south in Tulsa. Take the East 71st street South to your destination.

From Texas via US-75N. Get on US-75North. Take the US-69North, OK-375 and US-75 North to east 71st street south in Tulsa. Take the East 71st street South exit from US-169 North/US-64 West. Continue on east 71st street south to your destination.

From Missouri via I-44 west. Get on I-44 west/MO-43 south to Tulsa. Take the 71st street south exit from US-169 South. Continue on east 71st street south to your destination.

From Kansas via I-35 South and US-412 East. Get on I-135 S/JS-15 S/US-81 South. Take I-35 South and US-412 East to East 71st Street South in Tulsa. Take the 71st street south exit from US-168 S/US-64 East. Continue on East 71st street south to your destination.
